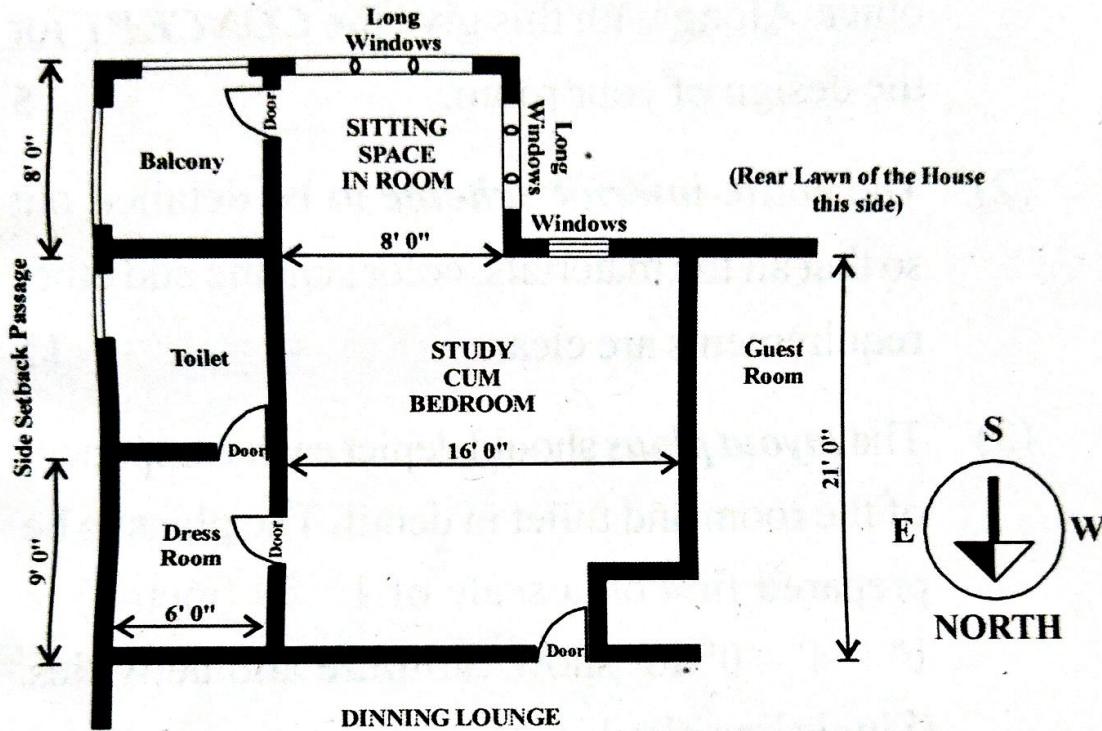
DESIGN BRIEF :

Your parents have bought a house in the Gomti Nagar area of Lucknow. It is a fairly large plotted house with large number of rooms. Now your childhood dream of occupying your own room is about to come true as your parents have told you that one room with an attached toilet will be given to you since you are studying for a professional course and require a proper environment for your studies. They have also allocated a certain budget for redoing the interior and the renovation and repairs of the entire house as it was previously occupied by somebody else.

An interior designer has been appointed for the project; however, you have been given a free hand to do up your own room as per your choice. The only condition they have laid down is that you must prepare all the drawings and views in advance and discuss it with the appointed interior designer so that work can proceed smoothly on site.

Now, your task is to prepare all the drawings as mentioned according to the given plan. Only the plan of your own room with toilet is being provided with

the adjoining areas mentioned. The north direction is also given for your reference. You need to focus on your own room set only for this exercise.

NOTE :

All dimensions are given; all walls can be considered as 9" thick brick walls for ease of drawing. Windows and ventilators may be added or removed, if required, but only after giving valid reason.

(1) Prepare a *list of requirements* you will need for your room e.g. bed, study table, wardrobe, storage, exercise, relaxation, toilet design, any other. Along with this give the **CONCEPT** for the design of your room. 15

(2) The entire *interior scheme* to be detailed out so that all the materials, color scheme and other requirements are clear. 15

(3) The *layout plans* should depict each component of the room and toilet in detail. The plans to be prepared first on a scale of 1 : 50 (metric) or 1" = 4' - 0" to show furniture and activities. (Single line plan).

Thereafter, the plans to be prepared on a larger scale of 1:25 (metric) or 1" = 2' - 0" so that more detailing is visible. All the walls, doors, windows, any other features to be shown properly along with furniture and fittings. 15

(4) Draw ONE sectional elevation to the scale of 1:25 (metric) or 1" = 2' - 0" through the room including as many elements possible to give a detailed understanding of the design. 10
